NANOBIOTECK- 2018 was being organised by Indian Society of Nanomedicine (ISNM) at All India Institute of Medical Sciences from 24th - 27th October, 2018. NANOBIOTECK-2018 is jointly hosted by All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi and Indian Institute of Technology, New Delhi in partner with Department of Biotechnology and Department of Science & Technology, Government of India and National Innovation Foundation.

The conference was aimed at providing an interdisciplinary and interactive platform for nano-scientists, engineers, clinicians, regulators, industry representatives, policy makers and related stakeholders to advance research and promote innovations and commercialization of Nano-enabled products to address various issues related to HealthCare.

The conference will focus deliberations around the following thematic areas:

- Tissue specific drug delivery vehicles for important diseases
- Nano-formulations for drugs to enhance their efficacy and therapeutic spectrum
- Diagnostics for early disease detection and Imaging
- Design and development of smart nano-materials/scaffolds, system and devices for medical application.
- Learning from failures-Promoting laboratory research leads for application development.
- Stakeholders View-B2B
- Safety and regulations for nano-products and processes.



Concurrent with the Conference, was an "Innovation Bazaar". The Innovation Bazaar was an open innovation marketplace for ideas around the theme of "new ways of working". The Innovation Bazaar was a concept that was located between the point of an idea and the first prototype, making it different to, and more inclusive than, other exhibitions/awards for innovation.

NANOBIOTECK - 2018 brought together 105 PIs and experts promoting Nano-Science development, expand capacity to address current and future development challenges. It also provided a valuable networking opportunity and set the stage for further cooperation among all the participants. Apart from that, NANOBIOTECK – 2018 registered a participation of 178 PhDs and post-graduate students, 85 students (including school children and undergraduate students) and 8 Company representatives. The event was sponosored by DBT, SERB.

NANOBIOTECK – 2018 began with a Pre-Conference "NANOMEDICINE SCHOOL to provide Basic and Simple Understanding of Nanomedicine for UnderGraduate/Post-Graduate/PhDs/Scientists from Basic Science/Engineering/Medical Background.
